
The model was stitched on 28 ct lugana fabric "Castel View" by Silkweaver - floss used Splendor Silk S861 Wedgewood Blue by Rainbow Gallery
Stitch count: 139 x 118 - Finish job about 24 x 19 cm stitching on 30 ct fabric
Suggested colour could be all of your fantasy! It's up to you!

I suggest you could use one of the follow dmc colour...

Blue shades : 3750 - 930 - 803 - 312

Red, pink and terracotta shades : 814 - 815 - 498 - 221 - 902 - 3777

Green shades : 500 - 924 - 3209 Brown shades: 300- 975 - 901-3862
